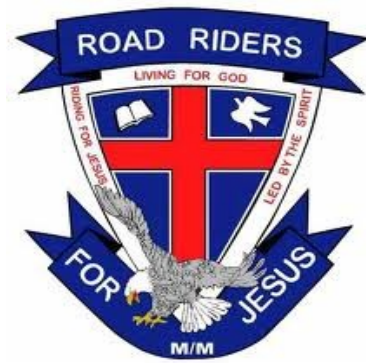

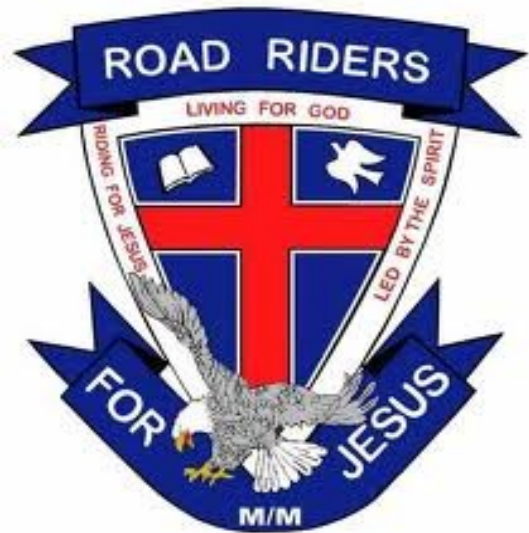

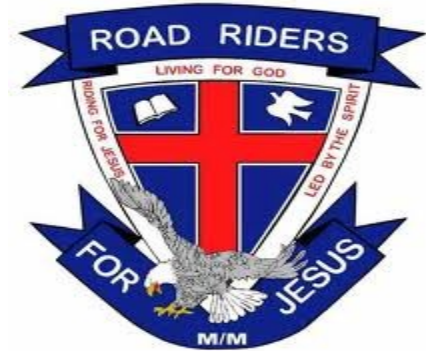

Unfortunately, Dan surrendered to the wrong influence which resulted in incarceration and years of substance abuse.

In his young adult years, Dan wandered in homeless and in substance abuse. He understands the world's pull and recognizes it around every corner. Dan can see the very heart of people who are experiencing or have experienced a similar journey to his and embraces every opportunity to share Jesus with them.

Dan met and married Laura in 1994 and the two became parents of their son Dylan in 1995. Laura has two daughters from a previous marriage and Dan embraced them as his own from the onset of their relationship. Dan and Laura enjoy their four grandchildren and are blessed to share Jesus with them through the word and play whenever they are around.

Laura accepted Jesus Christ as her Savior in 1976 but in 1984 made the choice to "wander in the wilderness" without a daily relationship with Jesus. For 17 years, Laura wandered and experienced great heartache as a result.

In 2001, the Lord used Dylan as the catalyst to lead Laura back to a relationship with Jesus and Dan to the place of accepting Jesus as his Savior and Lord. Over the years Dan and Laura have experienced great trials and witnessed the power, peace, strength, freedom, and great blessings that come from trusting Jesus. 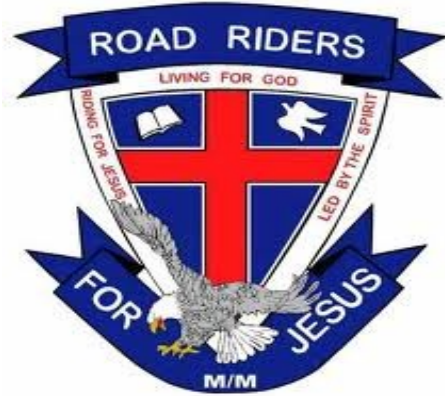
